

## **VISITATION GUIDELINES**

In accordance with California Dept. of Public Health (CDPH), the following visitor guidelines will be in place to ensure the safety of our patients and healthcare personnel:

- ❖ All visitors must be screened for fever and Covid-19 symptoms and must not be suspected or recently confirmed with Covid -19 (within previous 10 days)
- ❖ Visitors are <u>not</u> allowed for patients who are being suspected for Covid-19 and / or confirmed with Covid-19, exceptions allowed for patients who are at end of life.
- All other patients (not suspected / confirmed with Covid-19):
  - May have up to two visitors at a time
  - o 1 hour per visit total
  - Visitors may switch as needed
  - This does not apply to Maternal and Child Health services.
    - Labor and Delivery, NICU and Postpartum may only have one visitor and there will be no switching allowed.
- All visitors must wear a facemask upon entry and other PPE as appropriate while in the patient's room.
- All visitors must physically distance from healthcare personnel and other patients / visitors that are not part of their group at all times while in the facility.
- ❖ Visitors should not walk around in hallways and must go directly to and from the patient's room. Visitors are not be permitted to the hospital's cafeteria.
