

VISITATION GUIDELINES due to COVID-19

In accordance with California Dept. of Public Health (CDPH), the following visitor guidelines will be in place to ensure the safety of our patients and healthcare personnel:

1. For private rooms, two family members permitted per day.
2. For semi-private rooms, one family member permitted per day.
3. Visitors are not permitted for patients who are confirmed as positive COVID-19 or for those being r/o for COVID-19 until negative results have been confirmed.
4. There will be **no IN and OUT privileges.**

For the specific populations listed below, these expanded visitation guidelines apply regardless of COVID-19 county positivity rate.

1. *Pediatric patients – 2 visitors per day*
2. *Patients in Labor and Delivery – 1 visitors per day*
3. *Patients at end-of-life – 2 visitors per day*
4. *Patients with physical, intellectual, and/or developmental disabilities and patients with cognitive impairments – 2 visitors per day*
5. *Students obtaining clinical experience - allowed*
6. *Surgery patients – 2 visitors per day*
7. *NICU patients - 2 visitors per day*
 - a. *Parents will be provided a BYD N95 mask by the NICU nurse.*
 - b. *Parents must show valid negative COVID -19 test result taken within 72 hrs. (PCR or Antigen Test)*
 - c. *Parents who visit for multiple consecutive days are required to show proof of a negative test at least every 3rd day (e.g. test on day 1, day 4, day 7, etc.)”*
 - d. *Parents may stay up to 2 hrs. maximum depending on the time allowed by appointment.*
 - e. *Visitation approved at the discretion of NICU Charge Nurse.*

❖ **All persons entering the facility must present:**

- **Identification** (DL, Senior ID, passport) and:
- **COVID-19 vaccination proof** showing complete 2-dose vaccination regimen (Pfizer or Moderna) or a completed one-dose vaccination regimen Johnson & Johnson.

OR

- **A valid negative COVID-19 test result** collected within **72 hours** (PCR or Antigen test)

- ❖ All visitors must be screened for fever and COVID-19 symptoms and be asymptomatic for COVID-19 and not be suspected or recently confirmed case (within prev. 2 weeks)
- ❖ All visitors must wear a face cover upon entry and other PPE as appropriate while in the patient's room.
- ❖ Visitors should not loiter in hallways and must go directly to and from the patient's room.
- ❖ Visitors are not be permitted to the hospital's cafeteria for the sole purpose of dining.
- ❖ Duration of visitation to be determined on a case-by-case basis.

We recognize that this is an extraordinary situation locally, nationally and globally and thank you for your support of these measures as a way to keep our patients, visitors, employees and community safe.
